

HEAVY HAUL RAIL LIMITED - THIRD PARTY DEPOT ACCESS TARIFF

Effective Date: 8th March 2026

This tariff sets out the charges, booking procedures and site information for third-party road-vehicle access to Heavy Haul Rail Limited's depot facilities.

For the full terms and conditions governing access to our facilities, please refer to the Third-Party Depot Access & Maintenance Services Agreement.

1. CHARGES

All charges are exclusive of VAT, which will be applied at the prevailing rate.

Service	Charge
TOPS wagon release	£51 per event
Road vehicle site access for repair/inspection	£185 per visit
Stabling (wagons remaining on site for more than 14 days)	£25 per wagon per day
Strategic spares stabling	£20 per wagon per day
Shunting – in-service resource	£467 (2 hour minimum), £233 per hour thereafter
Shunting – dedicated resource	£1,473 per event

Definitions

Visit: One entry to a site by third-party personnel or contractors in a calendar day, regardless of the number of individuals attending or duration of attendance.

Event: A discrete administrative or operational activity requested by or on behalf of the third party or required for return to traffic of a wagon.

Day: A midnight-to-midnight period or any part thereof.

Stabling charges: Commence from day 15 onwards for wagons remaining on site for more than fourteen (14) consecutive days and accrue daily thereafter until the wagon is removed from site.

Tariff Reviews

Charges are reviewed annually on 1 April each year and may be increased by the percentage increase (if any) in the Retail Price Index (RPI) over the preceding twelve (12) months.

Heavy Haul Rail Limited reserves the right to amend charges at any time upon thirty (30) days' notice.

BOOKING PROCEDURES

How to Book

All road vehicle access to sites must be requested in advance via:

Advance Notice Requirements

Booking requests must be submitted:

- Five (5) Business Days in advance for routine maintenance, inspection or stabling activities; or
- Two (2) Business Days in advance for urgent safety-critical work.

Required Information

Each booking request must include:

- a. the identity of the site;
- b. the nature and scope of work to be undertaken;
- c. the date and estimated duration of access required;
- d. the number and names of personnel requiring access;
- e. wagon identification numbers (where applicable); and
- f. confirmation that all personnel hold valid site inductions.

Response Times

Heavy Haul Rail will respond to booking requests within:

- Two (2) Business Days for routine requests; or
- Four (4) hours for urgent safety-critical requests.

Cancellation

Cancellations may be made by providing written notice to Heavy Haul Rail.

Cancellations made with less than two (2) Business Days' notice will incur a cancellation fee of fifty per cent (50%) of the applicable charge.

Heavy Haul Rail may cancel or modify any confirmed booking where reasonably necessary for safety, operational or regulatory reasons.

ACCESS REQUIREMENTS

Site Induction

- All personnel accessing sites must have completed a valid Heavy Haul Rail site induction within the preceding twelve (12) months.
- Inductions can be arranged by contacting the Engineering Department.

Competence and Safety

- All personnel must be competent and appropriately qualified for the tasks they are undertaking.
- All personnel must comply with applicable laws, Railway Industry Standards (including Railway Group Standards and ROGS 2006), and Heavy Haul Rail site rules.
- Heavy Haul Rail reserves the right to refuse entry to or remove from any site any individual who does not meet these requirements or poses a safety or security risk.

Insurance

Third parties must maintain:

3. public liability insurance of not less than £5,000,000 per event;
4. employer's liability insurance at statutory levels; and
5. such other insurance as may be reasonably required by Heavy Haul Rail.

Evidence of insurance must be provided before first access and annually thereafter.
